Any Butterfly collectors out there? Captured in bargello, this butterfly will tickle your sense of color. Learn how the manipulation of a traditional pattern led to a delightful representation of one of nature's delights. Stitched on 18 count canvas using Silk & Ivory threads as well as #3 pearl cotton, this design stitches up quickly and can be finished in a variety standard frame shapes making it a versatile design and easy to finish. Students will learn the basics of bargello embroidery, how to follow a design pathway, and understand how color can create dimension.



This design is easy enough for a beginner and interesting enough for those well versed in bargello.

the Monarch,



and the Blue Morpho.
