Design size: 8" x 16"

Make a beautiful crazy quilted wall hanging working with a limited palette and full-size patch patterns. Focus is on creating fabulous seam embroidery and embellishments.

Plan Ahead for 2020 GCCs Facilitated by GLR

Each year the Great Lakes Region facilitates up to three Group Correspondence Courses. The teaching fees are covered by GLR. Students are responsible for the cost of the manuals, plus a \$ 10 surcharge to cover shipping and incidentals. Participants must furnish their own supplies for classes.

Class options for 2020 vary in technique and proficiency level. Selections include an intermediate multi-media beaded project, an advanced temari class, and a white on white crazy quilt. The subsidized financial support offered by GLR makes a cost-effective way for individuals or small chapters to participate in this education program learn embroidery techniques with which you are not familiar, or expand current skills. They may also be a stepping stone toward Individual Correspondence Courses or Mastercraftsman

Expect your manuals to arrive in late January or early February 2020. Projects for all offered classes will be due for evaluation October 15, 2020. Registrant pays for the initial shipment of pieces for evaluation to the coordinator. The registration fee includes the cost of the manual plus a \$ 10 surcharge to cover all other shipping expenses and incidentals.
