## INDIANA AUTUMN

Toni McKelley has designed a needlepoint piece specifically for our September 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting. The official quilt block of the State of Indiana serves as the background, with autumn leaves and acorns incorporated into the pattern. Clever use of the Amadeus stitch allows the stitcher to create the ovals that form the quilt block. Cotton and silk threads in traditional fall colors (greens, golds, rusty red and hint of brown) provide the palette. The unofficial nickname for the piece is "Thank you, Jean Hilton," since Jean was the inspiration for the stitches used in the piece. Come have a fun fall afternoon.

Toni has a background in art, which has enhanced her love of teaching color and design and many types of stitching. Her favorite type of stitching is Elizabethan embroidery, also known as traditional stumpwork, which calls for the use of a single strand of silk to build up characters and flowers on a silk background. It is similar to, but not the same as, what we know as Stumpwork today.



Among the array of needlework Toni teaches is linen work, canvas work, drawn and pulled work, Ukrainian openwork, Hardanger, quilting (particularly needle-turn appliqué), and surface work. She has taught at EGA and ANG chapters in Ohio, Michigan and Pennsylvania, and will be teaching at Michigan State Day, in July. She has also taught correspondence and online cyber classes for ANG.
