TECHNIQUE: Silk and Metal Threads on Canvas

LENGTH OF CLASS: 1 day (6 hours)

PROFICIENCY LEVEL: Beginner to Intermediate

SIZE: The design is approximately 6"x 4" on a 8" x 10" congress cloth foundation.

LOCATION: Prince of Peace Lutheran Church, 930 Higgins Road, Schaumburg, IL 60195

CLASS DESCRIPTION: This class is for the beginning Silk and Metal student who would like to learn more of the basic techniques of this embroidery. The luminescence created by the silks and metallics along with the simple yet exquisite stitches will enhance the students delight in needlework.

There is ample use of the techniques presented to allow the student to become familiar and confident with them. Included techniques are: laying flat silk over braid in Burden Stitch, diagonal satin in Soie Cristale and Pink Ling silk, upright Long and Short in Ping Ling silk, attaching beads, and couching La Lamé and Japanese Twist.

Kay Stanis is an internationally known fiber artist, designer, Master Craftsman, and Certified and Graduate Certified Teacher of the Embroiderers' Guild of America, Inc. (EGA) and Kurenai Kai Traditional Japanese Embroidery. Her embroideries have received numerous awards and have been shown on the covers of Kurenai, Inspirations, NeedleArts, and NeedlePointers. She exhibits her needlework widely and is a juried member of the Fiber Forum group and is the recent recipient of EGA's Diana Grossman Memorial Award for Excellence in Needlework. She has recently won a Judge's Choice award.

She has been, and will be on the faculties of American Needlepoint Guild national seminars, Callaway School of Needlearts, Embroiderers' Association of Canada, EGA national and regional seminars, Koala Conventions, South Australia Embroidery Conference, Embroidery 2000 (New Zealand), and many independent groups.
