



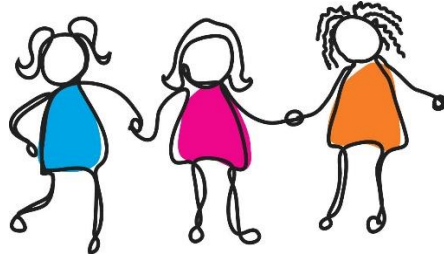

An Invitation to Friends ‘N Stitches 2025

Dear GLR Stitchers:

The Three Rivers Chapter has members from all around the Pittsburgh, PA area, as well as friends across the United States that have joined us for one event or another. For those very reasons, our theme for the 2025 Spring Retreat of “Friends ‘N Stitches” is so appropriate.

As offered in the past, we are providing the opportunity for you to join your friends to sit and stitch on your favorite pieces of what is commonly referred to as “Studio Time” over a three-day weekend of May 2nd, 3rd, and 4th of 2025. Stitch on a new project or a favorite one you have been meaning to complete. Enjoy the company of other stitchers while working at your own pace and taking breaks on your own schedule. Space will be provided for all three days for stitching – no teacher and no kit fee during stitch-in time – with all meals thrown in as well – all three days, for one low price!

Even though we’re not offering “classes”, we will be having periodic “Flashes” over the three days to give familiar (and maybe not familiar!) brief demonstrations that you may enjoy:

- Creating a tassel using pearl cotton
- Ironing your floss
- Knotting tip: Drawing a thread
- Tips for stitching on black fabric
- Those darn confetti stitches. One way to stitch confetti (random) stitches
- What can you share?

These policies, in addition to our normal policies, will be in force for the GLR retreat:

- Friends ‘N Stitches 2025 will occur unless a government mandate would force cancellation, or if EGA or the Great Lakes Region feel it is unsafe for us to gather in person.
- All State of Ohio and City of Kent mandates will be in effect.

Registration Information: Process and Instructions

Registration is open to members of EGA (either member of an EGA chapter or member-at-large). Non-members may register for an additional \$50 (US Dollars) fee which is applicable toward an EGA membership with a chapter in GLR, or as a member at large. All persons present at a Friends 'N Stitches Stitch-in must be registered seminar participants.

Regular registration opens Saturday, October 26, 2024. All registrations will be processed first come/first served, according to the date received, not the postmark.

Registration **closes March 30, 2025.**

Cancellations: Cancellation requests must be made to the Registrar no later than February 1, 2025. A refund, less a \$50 non-refundable registration fee, will be mailed by June 1, 2025. See complete cancellation policy on page 5 of this booklet.

Registration form: Online registration is preferred. You will receive a copy of your completed registration form via email which includes a link for online payment; please save it for your records.

Registration Options:

The three-day registration fee is \$259. Fees include all meals: three on Friday, three on Saturday; two on Sunday. Hotel registration is directly with the hotel.

Commuter option: For those who live within a 40-mile radius of Kent, Ohio, in addition to the registration, should you opt out of some of the fun of staying at the hotel to return home each night, there is an additional commuter fee of **\$50**.

Individual Days – drop-in option: If you are only able to come for one day, that is an option on the registration form. A partial commuter fee is included in the price.

- Friday only drop-in with meals: \$150
- Saturday only drop-in with meals: \$150
- Sunday only drop in-with meals: \$75 (no dinner)

NOTE: You must be a registered guest at the Kent State University Hotel to participate in the Friends ‘N Stitches GLR Retreat. Exceptions are a local paying a commuter fee, or a one-day drop-in registrant.

GLR Seminar/Retreat Cancellation Policy

Great Lakes Region Policies and Procedures Governance Seminar/Cancellation (09–2013)

Canceled participant must send cancellation notification via email. The registrar will reply promptly.

Cancellations received on or before February 1 of the seminar year will receive a refund less the non-refundable registration fee (\$50).

Cancellations received between February 2 through 60 days prior to the opening of the seminar (March 2) will incur a \$100 cancellation fee in addition to the non-refundable registration fee.

Cancellations received 0-59 days (by March 3 or later) prior to the opening of the seminar will be reviewed by the region's Executive Committee within 30 days of close of seminar.

A full refund minus the non-refundable registration fee will be given in the event of the death of the registrant or a member of the immediate family, and acts of war regarding registrant's reassignment. Immediate family may include spouse, domestic partner, child, parent, parent-in-law, grandparent, grandchild or sibling. A partial refund may be granted in the event of serious illness of the registrant or an immediate family member, or a natural disaster preventing the registrant's attendance. Consideration in determining the amount of the refund shall be given to the costs incurred by the seminar.

No refunds will be considered after 30 days of close of seminar/retreat.

In the event the Great Lakes Region cancels a class after students have been assigned, and a student chooses not to attend seminar, the seminar fee less the non-refundable registration fee will be reimbursed. Any travel costs the student has incurred are solely the responsibility of the student.

Name Tags: Many (if not all) of us have name tags in our stitching kits. We are asking everyone to bring a favorite name tag (or several) to share while at our Retreat. Please be sure at least your first name is large enough for the person next to you to read your name.

Supplementary Lighting: Please observe EGA's new guideline regarding supplemental lights. Any lights brought into the classroom must be battery-operated with no cords attached. This guideline was adopted to accommodate contracts with hotels regarding use of electric lights and extension cords.

Volunteer Opportunities: If you can help (e.g. at Merchandise Night, meals, etc.), indicate interest on your registration form.

Merchandise Night is one of the most popular events at seminar. You'll find designers, chapters, the GLR, local shops, teachers, and other vendors with tables stocked with everything you want, "need," and "can't live without." It is a great opportunity to see items that may not be available in your area. This event is also open to the public, so invite your friends! If you would like to be a vendor and sell at Merchandise Night, tables can be reserved for \$60 for a full table, \$30 for a half table, or \$25 for a chapter table.

Opportunity Baskets: Tickets for the Great Lakes Region's annual fundraiser will be sold during the seminar. Participants place their tickets in bags attached to the items they hope to win. The drawings will take place during the Sunday, May 4 luncheon. All items available are donated by region chapters or members. Tickets will be sold during the Retreat and at Merchandise Night.
