The stitches include chain stitch, fly stitch, french knots, long and short shading, outline/stem stitch, split stitch and straight stitch. Sample is done in shades of blue, but choose your own color family to create this charming floral embroidery.


Uncommon Stitches

Surface embroidery, Intermediate

Do you collect unusual stitches—then you may want to try this GCC. Start with common stitches then build on them to work Linked Chains, Corded Detached Buttonhole two ways, Plaited Braid with a Twist, Corded Lark's Head, Figure 8 Circle, Ladder Braid, Raised Knot, Looped Edge Threaded Back Stitch. Combining silk and metal threads, create a central wyvern-filled oval surrounded by typical flora and bugs. It employs a raised work technique often used historically.

Pulled thread, Intermediate

Work linear and diaper patterns with an emphasis on tension which creates the change in the texture of the fabric. Follow detailed diagrams for the stitches, and learn how to transit rows without distortion. The clover leaves and blooms contain twelve pulled fillings in a variety of patterns.

Use the set colors or choose your own. Personalize the central area with representations of your pets, or choose flowers or shrubs with colors from your own garden, or create a pristine lawn.
